Response is 'The applicant has contacted us on the removal of the hedge, explaining that it is in poor condition and he would like to ensure the new residents have a low maintenance fence for privacy and to provide more screening from the noise and fumes from parked cars at the station. We do have a preference for a replacement hedge but acknowledge that this is unlikely to up upheld at appeal. We have therefore sought advice from the Council's landscape officer and she has suggested that the soft planting can be achieved in front of the fence to soften its appearance. We are seeking details on this from the applicant to secure in the current application. The response was sent to District and County Councillors.
