T1 – Maple – crown reduce canopy by 3m to allow more light and re shape  
T2 – Lime – crown reduce canopy by 6m to allow more light and reduce weight out of tree  
T3 – Lylandii – Fell to ground level due to tree growing to large for area.  
Reduction would not benefit tree IMO. Multi stem potential hazard in bad weather.
