5.1 **128 High Street** **20/1481/TTCA**
Tree work to be completed
T1 – Maple – crown reduce canopy by 3m to allow more light and re shape
T2 – Lime – crown reduce canopy by 6m to allow more light and reduce weight out
of tree
T3 – Lylandii – Fell to ground level due to tree growing to large for area.
Reduction would not benefit tree IMO. Multi stem potential hazard in bad weather.
Re plant with Evergreen.
Application has been noted and the Planning Committee have no comments on

all.

13 Chiswick End S/4376/19/FL has been granted permission for a detached garage and
carport outbuilding and single storey detached annexe.
